Learning Sequence	Resources
After reading text, locate onomatopoeia words	<ul><li>Paper</li><li>Pencils, crayons, textas.</li></ul>
Students close eyes and listen to any sounds they can hear around them.	
List sounds on whiteboard.	
<ul> <li>Go outside classroom and repeat listening process and record new sounds.</li> </ul>	
<ul> <li>Children then choose a sound and illustrate e.g. tap tap illustrated with a bird pecking on a tin roof.</li> </ul>	
Create a class book from illustrations. Teacher can scribe.
